

## **Access to the Palais des congrès – Sunday, May 31 (Tour de l'Île 2026)**

We would like to inform you that, unlike previous years, the Tour de l'Île 2026 route will pass through the streets surrounding the Palais des congrès de Montréal on Sunday, May 31, 2026. This situation, which is beyond our organization's control, will result in significant traffic disruptions in the area.

Between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m., several streets will be closed to vehicle traffic, including:

- McGill Street
- Saint-Antoine Street
- Saint-Laurent Boulevard

Pedestrian and bicycle access will remain possible.

### **Access to the Palais des congrès by car**

Access to the indoor parking garage (1025 Chenneville Street) will remain possible via Viger Avenue only, approaching from Saint-Urbain Street. However, it will not be possible to cross Saint-Laurent Boulevard by car.

Please note that Sherbrooke Street and the Ville-Marie Expressway will remain open to traffic.

### **Alternative parking options**

Several nearby parking options will remain accessible, including:

- Place des Arts area
- Guy-Favreau complex
- CHUM area (recommended for arrivals from the east)
